Advanced Remote Salt Monitor

No fiddly buttons to remember to press here, the Ensign remote salt monitor is completely automatic. The new smart monitor first developed by Ensign in 1990 is located remotely, and provides a discrete bleep with adjustable volume and gentle blinking LED when your water softener actually needs refilling with salt.

It's the only water softener that checks the salt level itself and lets you know about 7 days before it actually runs out. It leaves those non-electric block salt water softeners in the dark ages.

A water softener without one of these is rather like owning a car without a petrol gauge.
